Nursery School Enrollment 2022 蘭・認定こども園 入園募集

If you want to enroll your child in Nursery school from next year, register as follows.

Who is eligible? All children living in Iga between the ages of 0 (no younger than 56 days old) and 5 who fulfill the Nursery school entry requirements. Please contact us for further details on these entry requirements.

Even if you wish to enroll your child after the start of the year (after May), you must still register at this time.

[Registration Period] 11 – 29 October, 8:30am – 5pm (weekdays only)

Enrollment forms will be available from 6 October at HoikuYouchien Ka in City Hall, any of the City Hall branch offices or any of the Nursery schools in Iga.



Infants Elderly

[Availability] 15 October - 31 January, 2022

[Eligibility] Registered as living in Iga and not yet school age

(Born after 2 April 2015)

[Amount] Up to 1,500 yen per vaccination (up to two times)
[Bringing] Health insurance card, mother-child passbook

(Boshi techo)

●In Iga

Make an appointment directly with the clinic. The amount you pay will already have the financial support included in it.

●<u>Outside Iga</u>

Upon application, the amount of the subsidized vaccination fee or the subsidized amount, whichever is lower, will be transferred to your account later.

[Eligibility] Registered as living in Iga and (1) or (2)

- (1) Over 65 years of age
- (2) Between 60 and 64, have heart, kidney, or respiratory organ dysfunction, or immunodeficiency caused by human immunodeficiency virus and are equivalent to Level 1 of the Physical Disability Certificate.

[Self-pay Amount] 2,000 yen [Bringing] Health insurance card

●<u>In Iga</u>

Make an appointment with the clinic directly.

Outside Iga

Please notify the following Kenkou-Suishin ka at least one week prior to the date of vaccination.

If you got the vaccination outside the city, please apply by February 28, 2022, along with a receipt showing that you received the vaccination and your bank account.

Have you Completed the Medical Checkup? 健康診管は お済みですか?

As applicable to the following, please complete the checkups by 30 November, Tuesday.

■Special Health Checkup

People who is over 40 and having national health insurance and who join the medical care system for the elderly

■Comprehensive Medical Examination (Kan'i Ningen Doc) of National Health Insurance
If you have the examination ticket, make an appointment with a medical facility and complete the checkup.

Prefectural Housing Applications Now Open 算營建管 艾蕾署 募集

[Application period] Between October 1st and 31st.

[Prefectural Housing] Please contact the following to ask for more details.

[Eligibility] 1 - Reside or work in Mie.

2 – Be in difficulty with your living conditions.

- 3 Have family members who will be living with you, or plan to do so
- Fiancees can apply, provided they register their marriage within 3 months of moving in
- Common-law couples can apply, provided they are not registered as married
- **4 –** Have a salary within the standard range designated by the Municipal Residence Law.
- **5 –** Must have no outstanding bills in rent, car parking etc if you already live in prefectural housing.
- 6 Not be behind in any tax payments
- 7 You must have two guarantors

Application forms can be found in any municipal office. Ask for "ken'ei juutaku no moushikomi sho"


Infant Health Checkups and Consultation 禁ちゃんの検診と**組談**

Tips for Everyday Life 生活のヒント

Door-to-door Collection of Oversize Garbage

粗大ごみ戸別収集

For those who have an address in the city, oversize garbage such as furniture, beds, bicycles, fan heaters, and home appliances will be collected. An oversize garbage disposal ticket worth 200 yen per item is required for collection. Up to 5 items can be collected at one time.

*Four designated home appliances (air conditioner, TV, refrigerator/freezer, washer/dryer,) cannot be collected.

1.- Call the Oversize Garbage Reception Center to apply.

2.- Purchase oversize garbage disposal tickets (200 yen) at supermarkets in the city.

3.- Put an oversize garbage disposal ticket on the garbage, and place it on the reserved day at the designated place by 9am. In Aoyama, the set time is 8:30.
