## **COVID-19 Updates** 新塑ュューチに関するお知らせ

#### Additional Vaccinations: Omicron Strain-Compatible Vaccines オミクロン株対応ワクチン追加接種

A new, additional COVID-19 vaccine for subvariants of Omicron will be administered soon.

[Inoculated Person] Persons 12 years of age or older who have completed 2 or more doses of vaccination [Inoculated Period] As soon as ready, depending on vaccine supply.

Vaccination tickets for eligible persons will be sent out sequentially starting in October. Details will be posted on the city's website.

## Nursery School Enrollment 2023 保育所 (薗) · 認定こども薗 『学園募集

If you want to enroll your child in the nursery school from next year, register as follows.

Who is eligible? All children living in Iga between the ages of 0 (no younger than 56 days old) and 5 who fulfill the nursery school entry requirements. Please contact us for further details on these entry requirements.

Even if you wish to enroll your child after the start of the year (after May), you must still register at this time.

[Registration Period] 11 – 31 October, 8:30am – 5pm (weekdays only)

Enrollment forms will be available from 6 October at Hoiku-Youchien-Ka in the City Hall, any of the City Hall branch offices or any of the nursery schools in Iga.

## Financial Support for Flu Vaccination インラネー・デー が表現を受けましょう

Infants, the elderly, and people with chronic illnesses should receive vaccination early before the epidemic occurs. No interval is required between influenza and COVID-19 vaccines.

> > [Vaccination Period] 15 October - 31 January, 2023

[Eligibility] Registered in the city and not yet school age (Born after 2 April 2016)

[Bringing] Health insurance card, mother-child passbook (Boshi techo)

[Subsidy Amount] Up to 1,500 yen per vaccination (up to two times)

■Vaccination in the City

Make an appointment directly with the clinic. The amount you pay will already have the financial support included in it.

● Vaccination outside the city

Upon application, the amount of the subsidized vaccination fee or the subsidy amount, whichever is lower, will be transferred to your account later.

[Eligibility] Registered in the city and meet (1) or (2) below

- (1) Over 65 years of age
- (2) Between 60 and 64, have heart, kidney, or respiratory organ dysfunction, or immunodeficiency caused by human immunodeficiency virus and are equivalent to Level 1 of the Physical Disability Certificate.

[Bringing] Health insurance card [Self-pay Amount] 2,000 yen

■Vaccination in the City

Make an appointment with the clinic directly.

■Vaccination outside the city

Please notify the above Kenkou-Suishin-ka at least one week prior to the vaccination date to complete the procedures in advance.

If you got the vaccination outside the city, please apply for a grant by February 28, 2023 with the following documents. -Receipt showing vaccination received -A bank book showing the payee

# Prefectural Housing Applications Now Open 原營住室 美語書

[Prefectural Housing] Please contact the following to ask for more details.

[Eligibility] 1 - Reside or work in Mie.

- **2 –** Be in difficulty with your living conditions.
- 3 Have family members who will be living with you, or plan to do so
- Fiancees can apply, provided they register their marriage within 3 months of moving in
- Common-law couples can apply, provided they are not registered as married
- 4 Have a salary within the standard range designated by the Municipal Residence Law.
- 5 Must have no outstanding bills in rent, car parking etc if you already live in prefectural housing.
- 6 Not be behind in any tax payments
- 7 You must have two guarantors

Application forms can be found in any municipal office. Ask for "ken'ei juutaku no moushikomi sho"

# Tips for Everyday Life 性語のヒント

# How to dispose of small home appliances containing lithium-ion batteries

リチウム電池入小型家電の出し方

Lithium-ion batteries in home appliances have been known to catch fire in landfills, posing a serious accident hazard; such as digital cameras, cell phones, mobile batteries, game consoles, electronic cigarettes, electronic shavers, mobile fans, rechargeable small vacuum cleaners, robot vacuum, etc.

#### North Iga; Ueno, Shimagahara, Iga, Ayama and Oyamada

Please leave the lithium-ion battery in the main body and place it in the collection box at the local civic center.

If it does not fit in the slot, please use the individual collection or bring it directly to the Sakura Recycling Center.

If the lithium-ion battery is removed from the main unit, tape and insulate it, and bring it directly to the Sakura Recycling Center.

Lithium-ion batteries will not be collected on landfill waste (Umetate Gomi) days.

#### South Iga; Aoyama

Please remove the lithium-ion battery from the main body, tape and insulate it, and put out on the day of recyclable (Shigen Gomi) or in the battery collection box at Aoyama Branch Office.

If a battery is leaking, put it in a plastic bag first and in the collection box.

If the lithium-ion battery cannot be removed from the main unit, please dispose of the entire unit as small home appliances garbage.

This minimum wage applies to everyone working in Mie Prefecture (Excluding those working in an industry with a designated minimum wage).
