## **COVID-19 Updates** 新型コロチに関するお知らせ

### 

Mie Prefecture asks for everyone's cooperation not to get infected and to prevent medical care shortages.

- 1) Take advantage of vaccination opportunities:
  - Especially Omicron strain-compatible and persons living with the elderly.
- 2) Thoroughly implement basic infection prevention measures: Wear masks, hand sanitizer, and ventilation.
- 3) Measures to prevent the spread of covid among elderly people at high risk of becoming seriously ill.
- 4) Measures for eating and drinking situations: wear masks or eat without talking as much as possible.
- 5) Preparing in case of poor physical condition:
  - Have COVID antigen test kits ready, antipyretic analgesics, thermometer, 5-7 days of food ration, and other basic essentials.
- 6) Appropriate receipt of medical care: Visit the emergency room if truly necessary, such as persistent high fever, inability to drink fluids, severe breathlessness, difficulty breathing, or impaired consciousness.

## School Funding System for Nursing / Care Worker 看護師・介護福祉士 修学資金制度

[Number of scholarships] A few [Eligibility]

Nurse:

Those who are enrolled in or attending a nursing school or college to obtain a nursing license and who will work as a nurse in a hospital after graduation.

Care Worker:

Those who are enrolled and attending a care worker training facility to obtain a care worker license, and who will work as a care worker in a hospital after graduation.

[Amount]

●Nurse: 50,000yen or 80,000yen / month

Care Worker: 50,000yen / month

[Exemption from Repayment]

If the student obtains the respective qualifications promptly after graduation and works at Ueno Sogo Municipal Hospital for a specified period, the student will be exempted from repayment of the training fund.




#### Application for My Number Card to get Myna-points will be Extended

# Tips for Everyday Life 単語のヒント

#### February 3, Setsubun, Japanese Setsubun Customs 2月3日は節分です

Setsubun means the parting of the seasons, and occurs four times a year: spring, summer, fall, and winter. Spring (Risshun), in particular, marks the beginning of a new year, and people pray for good health and happiness throughout the year by warding off evil spirits.

On Setsubun day, people throw beans. The entrance and windows are opened and the beans are thrown while saying "Oni wa soto" (Out, ogre, out!) to drive away the evils in the house, and "Fuku wa uchi" (Blessed, come inside our house!) to bring the happiness into the house. After the bean-throwing, people eat one more number of beans than the number of your age.

Recently, people have started to eat "Ehomaki", a sushi roll, on Setsubun day. It is said good fortune is rolled up in a sushi roll. When you eat "Ehomaki", you have to keep some promises;

- Without cutting into pieces to prevent good fortune from being cut into pieces
- Without talking so that happiness does not escape from your mouth.
- While making a wish, facing the direction in which the god of the year will come, south-southeast this year. On February 3, why don't you have a bean-throwing ceremony with your family and then eat sushi rolls facing 'south-southeast" silently?
