■ Pneumococcal Vaccination for the Elderly 高齢者肺炎球菌の予防接種

Those who turn 65 this year are eligible for pneumococcal vaccination. The cost of the vaccination is 3,000 yen. After receiving the notice, please make an appointment directly with the respective medical institution.

Tips for Everyday Life 単語のヒン

Don't Bring Meat into Japan! 南の持込禁止

Animal quarantine information for travelers to Japan.

Several people have been arrested on suspicion of illegally importing livestock products using international parcels. (March 1, 2022)

Those who illegally bring in livestock products are subject to imprisonment for up to three years or a fine of up to 3 million yen (up to 50 million yen for corporations).

Violators would be punishable with imprisonment or fine.

- ▶You cannot bring meat products, such as meat, ham, sausages and bacon, into Japan from most countries without inspection certificate.
- ▶Please inform your family and acquaintances overseas not to send meat products while you are staying in Japan.
- If by any chance you have received meat products that was not inspected, you need to notify your nearest Animal Quarantine Service immediately.

Financial Support for School-goers

Iga City can provide some financial support to those who have difficulties with school-related costs such as school meal fees, school materials.

If you wish to access this support, you must apply every year. The support is only offered on an annual basis, so if you receive the support this year, you do not automatically receive it again next year.

* Support will not be available where it coincides with support available under welfare support.

[Eligibility] Guardians of students enrolled in a municipal elementary or junior high school. *Income thresholds apply.

[Eligibility] 1. Be in difficulty with your living conditions.

- 2. Have family members living with you, or plan to do so
- 3. Have a salary within the standard range designated by the Municipal Residence Law.
- 4. Must have no outstanding bills in rent, car parking etc if you already live in the prefectural housing.
- 5. Not be behind in any tax payments
- 6. You must have two guarantors
